

**PASTOR'S NOTES:****Dear Parishioners and Visitors,**

As this Lenten Season comes to its conclusion, we are going into the Holy Week.

This Sunday is called Palm Sunday. On the first Palm Sunday, Jesus entered Jerusalem and people welcomed Him. When we hold palm branches, we say to ourselves that we are following Jesus, our King.

**1/ On Holy Thursday, April 13, 2017**, we will have a **Chrism Mass** at St. Francis de Sales at 10:30AM. Each parish will have a lay person to receive the oils.

**St. Ann Catholic Church will celebrate the Last Supper of Jesus at 7:00PM.** The Lenten Season at St. Ann Church will be ended at this time. We will enter into the Triduum. The Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil) is one event.

**At the end of the Eucharistic Celebration, the Blessed Sacrament will be transferred to the St. Ann Parish Center until 12:00Midnight.** Would you be with the Lord for a half hour or one hour?

**2/ On Good Friday, April 14, 2017**, we will have the **Way of the Cross at 3:00PM.** It reminds us that Jesus died for our salvation. After the Way of the Cross, we will have the Veneration of the Cross, Then, we will have Holy Communion. It is a day of prayer and fast. It is not a day to party.

**3/ Holy Saturday (Easter Vigil) begins at 8:00PM** with the blessing of the fire (every Catholic Church in the Diocese). Then the Paschal Candle will be brought into the Church in darkness. It means Jesus comes to us alive. He is the Way, the Truth and the Light to lead us to His Father in Heaven. We will have 2 adults who will be baptized into the Catholic Church.

**Easter Sunday Masses will be at 8:00AM and 10:00AM.** We who were baptized into the Catholic Church renew our Baptismal Promises to follow Jesus Christ faithfully in our daily lives.

Holy Week is a very special week in our salvation. Would each one of us make an effort to attend Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil?

Let us open our minds and hearts to Jesus. He comes to bring us life. He does not look at our sins, but He is looking for us to return to Him.

Because of Jesus' death, the gate of heaven is opened for us. Will your love be for Jesus Christ?
