

What's Coming: The Weekly Bulletin

Greetings brothers and sisters,

I am writing today to explain how I want to use this section of our weekly bulletin. I want to make the bulletin a place where you can go weekly to find relevant information for your faith life as well as to stay connected to St. Ann's parish life. This will serve as one of my regular lines of communication to you all. Each week of the month will have different kinds of information.

On the second Sunday of the month, you should expect a "Kerygma" article. In Kerygma, we will explore the initial proclamation of the Gospel. We will dive into the basic tenants of the Christian faith. Often our faith is based on what we have passively absorbed from our parents. As such, it can be a daunting task to talk with other people about our faith. How would you answer these questions: What is being catholic all about? Why should I be catholic? If these questions would be difficult to answer, this column will be for you.

On the third Sunday of the month, you should expect a "What's Coming" article. This will be our regular line of communication of major parish events. When there are changes that effect our whole parish community they will be announced and explained here. This will touch on upcoming liturgical seasons and major events. For instance, you should expect an article about advent here the month before the beginning of Advent.

On the fourth Sunday of the month, you should expect a "Question Father" article. In Question Father, you will be able to ask the questions you have always meant to ask a priest. Often questioning lets us get directly to the spot where our faith is challenged, we can voice concerns that others can benefit from. On the fifth Sunday of the month when there is one, you should expect a "Ramblings" article. This article will be about miscellaneous topics that do not fit well into the other columns. This article will be less formal and will be about whatever I feel like talking about. On the first week of the month, I will not usually write an article, but I may have quest writer to cover that week. At the end of each article, you should expect a *Learn More* section. *Learn More*, will give you places to dive deeper into the topic at hand or to broaden you understanding of Catholicism in general.
