A Note From Bishop Shelton Fabre: As you are aware, Hurricane Harvey has caused widespread devastation in Houston and other areas of Texas as well as in areas of southwestern Louisiana. We commend to God those who have died as a result of this natural disaster. May God grant them eternal rest and peace. Our hearts and prayers also go out to all who have been affected by this disaster. May God grant them consolation, strength, courage, and hope as they rebuild their lives. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has called for a second collection to assist affected areas in recovering from this disaster. In the Diocese of Houma-Thibodaux, this second collection is to be taken up in all church parishes the weekend of

September 9th and 10th. The proceeds of the collection will be used both to support the humanitarian and recovery efforts of Catholic Charities USA and to provide pastoral and rebuilding support to impacted dioceses.
