

PASTOR'S NOTES:

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

The Bourg Home Associate, Inc (The St. Ann Council # 8932 the Knight of Columns) donated the property and buildings to St. Ann Catholic Church, Bourg, Louisiana.

I met with the members of our Pastoral Parish Council and the Financial Committee. I explained to them about the situation and what we will do and how much the cost will be to do the project. After discussion, all members accepted the donation. The members voted to accept the estimate with: 9 Yes and 1 Abstain.

I sent the letter to the Bishop Shelton J. Fabre for an approval to accept and demolish. Bishop Shelton J. Fabre who is the president, authorized Rev. Ty Van Nguyen, secretary, to accept an Act of Donation from Bourg Home Association LLC - the Property and Buildings located at the address of 4346 & 4350 Hwy 24, Bourg, La.

On Thursday, April 13, 2017, Rev. Ty Van Nguyen signed the document. Grand Knight Ivy J. Dupre, Jr. represented for the Bourg Home Association, Inc. On Monday, April 17, 2017, the Property and Buildings located on 4346 & 4350 Hwy 24, Bourg, La. belong to St. Ann Catholic Church.

On behalf of the St. Ann Catholic Church - The Parishioners and myself - we deeply appreciate the Bourg Home Association, Inc (The St. Ann Council #8932 the Knights of the Columbus) donating this treasure to us!

With the approval of the Bishop Shelton J. Fabre, we will demolish the buildings and remove things from the grounds... and add some more dirt on the property.... Bryan Talbot, Inc. will begin the project soon. Then, we will fence the border on one side of the poverty. The total cost of the project is: \$35,014.00

After this project, St. Ann Catholic Church still has in the Central Fund with the Diocese: \$383,935.57 (Diocese Central Fund) - \$35,014.00 (Cost of Project) = \$358,882.81

I thank each and everyone who supports my ministry at St. Ann. With your working with me, we have moved St. Ann Catholic Church to as it is now.

This weekend is Divine Mercy Sunday. The late Holy Father John Paul II declared the first Sunday after Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday. In the following words, Our Lord said to Sister Josefa: "On Friday, 20th of October, towards seven o'clock in the evening, she just finished her adoration before the Blessed Sacrament when Jesus appeared bearing His Cross. 'Josefa,' He said, 'share with me the flames that are consuming my Heart: I thirst for the salvation of souls... O! If only they would come to Me!... If they but had confidence in Me.' 'I am all love.' He continued, 'I have chosen them that I may find comfort in them and overwhelm them with my favour... I will condone all their miseries... What I want them to realize is that I love them more tenderly still, if after their weakness and falls they throw themselves humbly into My Heart; then I pardon them... And I love them still.'" (The Way of Divine Love, p. 198)

Mark Toups: Between Divine Mercy Sunday and Pentecost Sunday, the celebration of our 40th Anniversary as a diocese, Bishop Fabre has called for an intentional time of prayer for each of our church parishes in the diocese. For the next 39 days, starting April 24, he is inviting us to join him in prayer each day for a different church parish in the diocese. You
